**MUTARA A: YITJANGA YOKUGHANEKERA** (yokushingonona/yokuthimwa)

- 1 Tjange matangero ghothithimwetwedha ghokutanga nothighamba thino: *Paguhura mugenda ghokufumana ghenenine ghuganya*. Muyitjanga yoye totithepo mupepo ghoyishamberera noghukaro.
- 2 Tjange thipindhi thokushingonona diyuwa dyomughuro. Muyitjanga yoye tokomene pawanu, dyango nomaywi gha sho gha ghamwene mutoyi mu ka thi ghanekera tihokoka tho.
- 3 Tjange yihokoka yokehe diyuwa **yiwadi yokukushera (pakatji komañando 250 – 300 mukehe thi)**. Thokutanga thamukashure mudiyuwa dyendi dyokuhurerera pashure dhosekondere; thoghuwadi ne thoghofotji ghopawamamitiri wendi oyu gha mu dimuka thikuma, modi diyuwa dyokuhurerera pashure. Muyitjanga yoye totithepo muhingo ghoyikuyuva noghukaro.
- 4 Tjange thipindhi thokushingonona thodina *Ndunda dhopithadho tii*. Muyitjanga yoye tokomene mutendo wadho nodyango dyapo mukughamwena mutoyi ghoye gha dhi ghanekere.

**MUTARA B: KUTJANGERA HATEGHERERI** (yokukuyonga/yoñanani)

- 5 Tjange mbapira kwaMukurughoshure dhenu omu ghuna kughayarera eshi ngo ngepi edi sho ha kuhatithere mo hakashure kuyaka kuhonga ndimi dhoThimbukushu pashure dhenu. Muyitjanga yoye totithepo yikuyuva yomakurupero noyishambereritha.
- 6 Magazini ghokuyuka wawamuregheya nga kwipura ghutjange katjangwa kodina eshi *Kutundithapo Dingungwa*. Tape yihokoka eshi ngepi edi ghokutenda yikara yodingungwa yikutjindje yokunyanyukitha mughuparo ghoye ghokehedyuwa. Muyitjanga yoye totithepo yikara yoyitotithapo noyishamberera.
- 7 Tjange mambapira **mawadi (ghopakatji mañando 250 – 300 mukehe thi)** kukorambudhi. Mbapira dhokutanga dhokukwatitha eshi mandimi ghomahe ghokakoghatji ngo ha ghatambure kugharughanitha pamuragho nodhimweya dhokukanunutha eshi Thihingirisha ngenyu ngo tho sho ha tambure kurughanitha paveta.
- 8 Tjange diywiwenditha dyomakurandokama dyokutjingitha filimu ghodina: *Kushamberera ghukuhonga maghundondoro ghomapya munyima dhoyikuhonga mushure*. Muyitjanga yoye totithepo marikanyethero ghopakatji koyipepaghura ghunyanyuka nokukuhonga ghundondoro ghoghupya.
