- Respond to **one** of the following topics in a piece of writing.
 - The content must be about **150 – 200** words in length.
- 1** You have a good friend whose parents are going through a separation. You are aware that he/she is going through a difficult time as he/she told you that he/she does not know how to cope with the situation. You are scared that he/she will take irrational decisions which may affect the close relationship your friend has with both his/her parents.

Write an honest **letter** of advice **to your friend**, suggesting how he/she could go about keeping and building even better relationships with both parents.
 - 2** You are a newly elected member of the Learner Representative Council at your school. You were involved in the organisation of a successful community service function to raise funds for the aged in your community. You now have been asked to write **an article** about it for your school magazine. You should also stress why it is important to look after the aged. Furthermore, you need to persuade the learners of your school to participate in the monthly collection drive at your school for the aged.
 - 3** You have been called into the principal's office as you have become a victim of cyberbullying. A fellow classmate has included your name and those of other classmates in an insulting rap song which he has composed and placed on YouTube. The principal has asked you to write **a detailed report** about the incident and previous bullying occasions which you had to endure from this person. Write the report.
 - 4** You are to write **two detailed diary entries**: one written by your grandmother or grandfather about an incident in her or his life many years ago; and the second diary entry by you about a similar incident in your life today.
