Fig. 1 shows the wooden spice rack that is to be made.

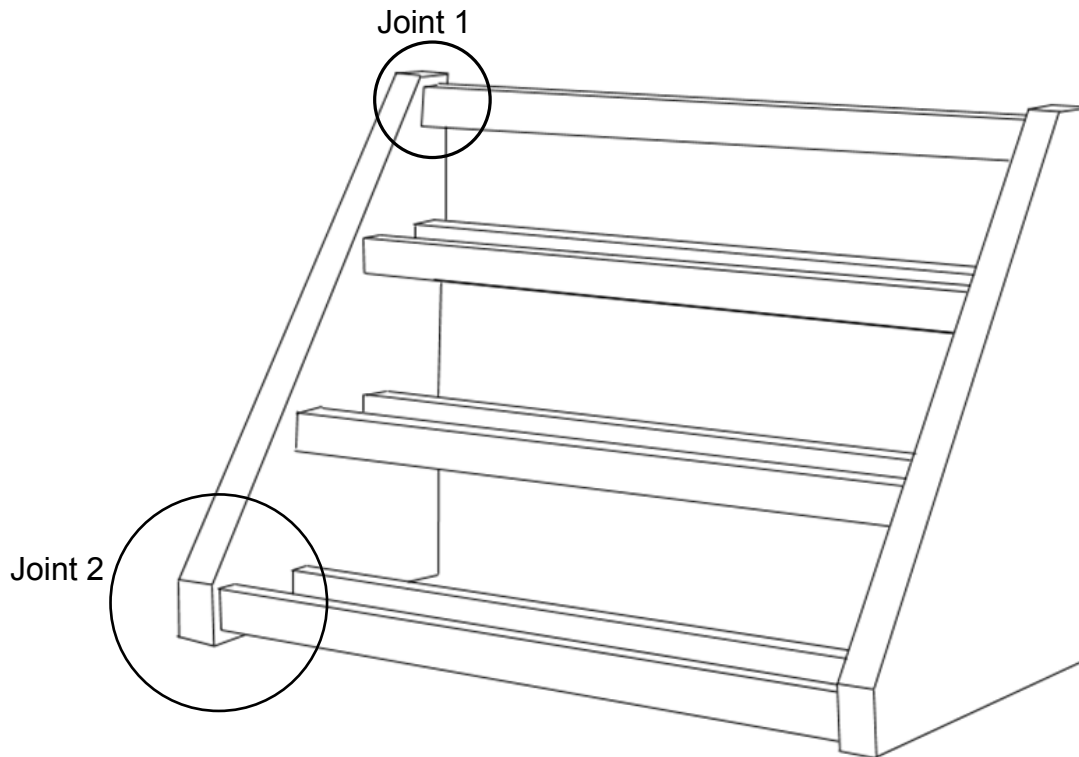

Fig. 2 shows an exploded view of the spice rack showing all the measurements of the parts and joints to be made.

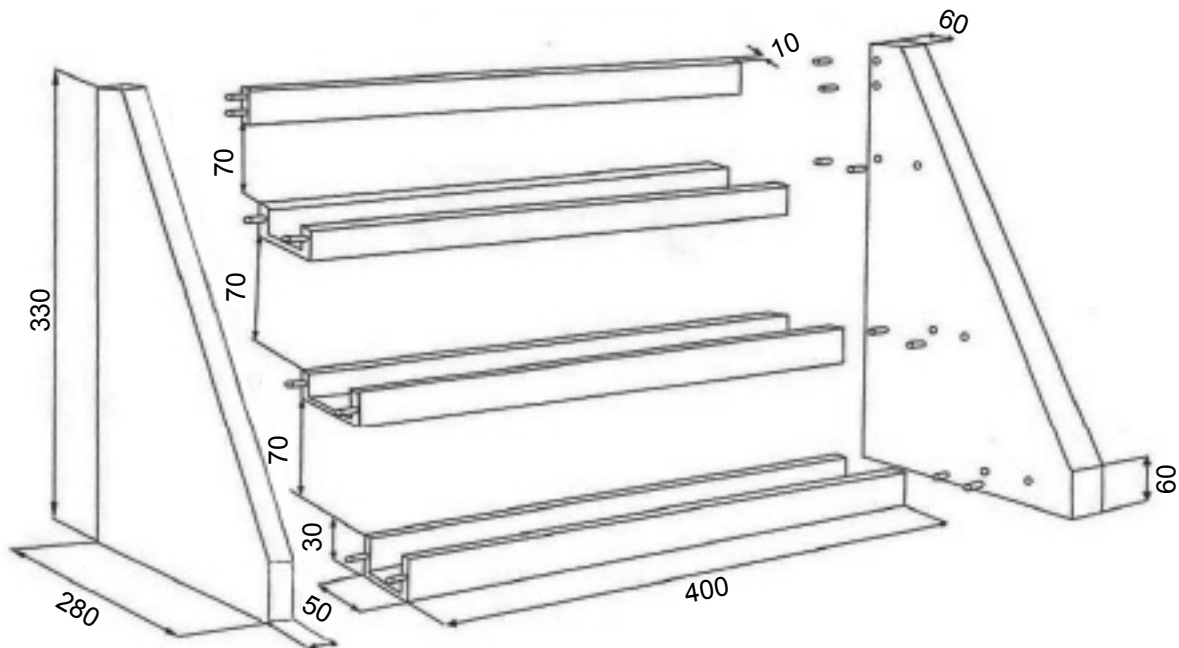
